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Covid Emergency Paid Sick Leave & Paid Family Leave

The temporary Covid-19 MA emergency sick leave has been extended through 4/1/2022. In spring 2020 MA established a statewide mandate for employers to temporarily provide employees up to 40 hours of EPSL due to specific qualifying reasons related to Covid-19. The law was set to expire on 9/30/21 but the MA legislature extended it through April 1.

MA Paid Family Leave was expanded as of 7/1/2021 to include not only employees but family members with a serious health condition or a family member's call to active duty.

Consult your employment attorney to ensure you are complying with all necessary regulations.

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


- **Q**. We have started thinking about the end of year processing. Are there tasks we should think about completing ahead of time to make sure we are prepared?
- **A.** Absolutely. If there are providers in the system that are no longer working in the practice, it is recommended to inactivate them before processing End of Year so they will no longer show in report filters. Review FAQ # 260
- **Q.** Our office has custom hours set up throughout the year that will be expiring soon. Should we consider removing these hours prior to end of year?
- **A.** Yes, it is recommended to delete expired custom hours from each provider. Additionally, now is a great time to make the change in the system for those to start at a future date. FAQ# 27451 reviews how to clean up custom hours.
- **Q.** I've noticed our system has many duplicate insurance companies. Should we consider reviewing this list and cleaning it up before we process end of year?
- **A.** Keeping your database up to date and clean is always a good practice to follow. FAQ #121 has other areas to consider cleaning up as well. Ask us how to specifically handle duplicate insurance companies.
- **Q**. We always did Year End in our old software, do we have to do End of Year in Fuse?
- **A.** Since Fuse is cloud based, the software knows when it is end of day, end of month or end of year. At 12:01 AM on 1/1/2022, Fuse will know that it is a new year and any report can be filtered appropriately. There is no end of period processing in Fuse.
